7:05PM - 7:20PM #weGiveCatholic update - Kathy Holaday Made a presentation on #weGiveCatholic. The St. Sebastian Parish Foundation is supporting this effort. The online day of giving is Tuesday, November 29th. The 2022 project is to replace the aging activity tables and chairs for the Kindergarten and Preschool classes.

7:20PM - 7:45PM Father's update Priests meeting with the bishop: Generally, if a parish was healthy pre-covid, then the parish is healthy after covid. If a parish was not healthy before then generally not healthy after. Diocese attendance at mass is doing very well.St. Sebastian attendance is down about 10% pre-covid vs. post covid.

St. Sebastian has over 1800 families now.

For the first time, St. Sebastian has to minister to 7 different generations. The focus will be on families with young children.

St. Sebastian has only 12 people in leadership roles in the parish; some are part time. Need to get parishioners more invested.

This weekend is priesthood Sunday.

Byrider updates are continuing. New windows are in.

The roof is almost finished.

Parking lot brick replacement will be next year; maybe start in January.
