Cinnamon requests that we spread the word for assistance. • • Altar Servers: • Maria was past due for their number 9 blessing on Friday...please pray for a safe delivery! • 12 servers have departed via graduations (middle and HS). Three have been added, but hope for more 5th graders to step up. Keith will put out a call at the beginning of the school year. • • Audio/Visual: • 5 attendees watch live stream live with 30-50 views total during the week. 20 live viewers on Sunday with 100-150 total views. • 3 techs cover daily mass and a number of teens assist on Sunday 9am. • Big Challenge: copyright claims coming in for music content. Auto-spammers troll for music sounds that are similar to copyrights, laying allegations of infringement against the parish. Claims range from \$350 to \$30,000 per song if not contested. Extremely time consuming...Lynn has been fantastic to counter the claims, but Cathy Sivic now has the task. No legal recourse in sight. • Possible solution: 1)Given the drop off in daily views, livestream less? • 2) Have someone pin down copyright info and respond to the claims...terribly time consuming! The spammers have gone back to every song played last year.
